takes five years' study to become a dentist. lain's degrees and fellowships, by comparison, took 14 years of study.

It's widely acknowledged that having someone with these skills and experience is a real asset to the region. Iain is immediately available; meaning that patients requiring urgent care don't have to go on waiting lists or fly to Wellington or Christchurch for treatment. Local access also means that patients can go home after procedures, sparing them potentially expensive hospital stays.

And being in Nelson – with its proximity to all the spectacular beaches, lakes and mountains – works perfectly for Jo and Iain as well.
